Disciplines covered: International Relations, comprising International and Comparative Politics, Foreign Policy Analysis, International Law, History of International Relations and Foreign Policy, and International Political Economy.

Quantitative-qualitative balance: Predominantly qualitative

Editorial philosophy: Revista Brasileira de Política Internacional (RBPI) was founded in 1958 and since then has been one of the leading venues for discussions about International Politics in Latin America. RBPI is an openaccess, pluralist peer-reviewed journal. It publishes articles focused on international and transnational relations, and embraces an interdisciplinary approach focused on theoretical, historical or policy-oriented research.
