Where is the journal indexed? Journal of Economic Literature, Sociological Abstracts, International Bibliography of the Social Sciences, Clase, Hispanic American Periodicals Index, Latindex.

Minimum and maximum length of articles: minimum of 16,800, and maximum of 84,000 characters

Languages of submission: Spanish

Translation policy: all articles appear in Spanish

Peer review process: Articles are subject to screening by two editors; those selected for peer review are sent to two external referees.

Approximate acceptance rate: 40%

Disciplines covered: Sociology, Political Science, Economics, History, Anthropology

Quantitative-qualitative balance: 20-80; authors should write with a multi-disciplinary audience in mind.

Editorial philosophy: To publish original research, usually based on primary sources and/or fieldwork. Occasionally, the journal translates and publishes articles of special interest for our Latin American audience.

Use of photographs or graphics: Monochrome in print and online version
