**Editorial philosophy:** Our editorial objective is to contribute to the advancement and dissemination of anthropological and archaeological knowledge, and to the critical analysis of sociocultural, methodological and theoretical topics that are relevant for the diverse subfields of the discipline and of other related areas of the social and human sciences. *Antípoda* constitutes an open, critical, pluralist forum in which hitherto unpublished articles and studies are published in Spanish, English and Portuguese. *Antípoda* has a special interest in disseminating the experiences and the results of anthropological studies and of social research on the anthropologies of the world, especially those of Latin America.
