Manuscripts should be no longer than 8,000 words of paginated, double-spaced 12 point text with 1-inch margins, including notes and references, with an abstract of approximately 150 words and 5 keywords, plus a separate cover sheet with author identification, affiliation and contact information, including e-mail and postal addresses. Manuscripts may be submitted in English, Spanish, or Portuguese. **LAP** will translate manuscripts accepted in languages other than English. If you do not write in English with near native fluency, we prefer to receive manuscripts in your first language.
